
♠ 16 to 23 January – Tasmania Bridge Holiday

This holiday features five nights at the waterfront Henry Jones Art Hotel in Hobart and two nights at Stewarts Bay Lodge on the Tasman Peninsula. Highlights include a cruise to visit the exciting MONA, a gourmet day trip to Bruny Island and a tour of historic Port Arthur. 
♥ 9 to 25 April – Spice Islands Bridge Cruise

We join the luxury *Seabourn Sojourn* in Darwin to sail to the remote Spice Islands of Bandaneira, Ambon and Ternate. 
♦ 30 April to 6 May – Noosa Bridge Holiday


♥ 18 to 21 September – Port Stephens Bridge Holiday
