The prices shown in this brochure are cruise-only prices. Bridge Away group prices are currently considerably cheaper than prices available through a direct booking with Seabourn. The cruise is already heavily booked and some cabin categories have limited availability. The US\$1500 cabin credit with Bridge Away cruise prices is only for bookings made up to Friday 6 September 2024. A deposit of approximately 25% of the cruise cost is required within two days of booking. Deposits are refundable for cancellations up to 13 June 2025.

To ensure embarkation on Sunday 12 October 2025, it is highly recommended that passengers arrive in Tokyo on or before Saturday 11 October 2025. Pre-cruise accommodation in a five-star hotel in Yokohama will be booked for the Bridge Away group for Thursday 11 October and costs for accommodation, transfers, tours and meals advised in January 2025.

Information about group flights with Business Class and Economy Class fares for flights from Australia to Tokyo and Osaka to Australia will be available in November 2024. Cruise booking conditions and travel insurance options will be advised once you have a confirmed cruise booking.
